Monorailex is the annual conference of the International Monorail Association with its goal to provide a platform to present new research and development of monorail systems and operational findings. This platform targets towards experts involved in transportation planning in communities and metropolitan regions, in the industry as monorail system suppliers, the supply and service industries for vehicles and infrastructure, researchers and operators for mass transportation for an exchange.

The International Monorail Association also welcomes researchers to submit their original articles, which can be of academic or of practical value, to be published for the first time. We seek contributions that illustrate the different transportation systems, and ways to enhance their efficiency and showcase opportunities for empowering citizens in finding solutions in mass transportation.

Monorailex is composed of presentations of scholarly papers and expert lectures sharing their experience with the professional audience.

A special feature of our conference will be again the "Technical Visits" – this year starting already on Friday, September 20 with a tour to Max Bögl's "Transportsystem Bögl" (TSB) and a visit to the leading trade fair for railway and transport technology "InnoTrans" on Tuesday, September 24.

From Airport Nürnberg

By public transport:

Take the U2 to Nuremberg Central Station, then switch to the RE train toward München Hbf. Get off at Bahnhof Neumarkt, then take bus 561 to Neumarkt Landratsamt right in front of the hotel or bus 563 to Neumarkt Neuer Markt just 160m from the hotel.

You can instead take the U2 to Nuremberg Central Station, then switch to the S3 and get off at Bahnhof Neumarkt. Walk 1.4km to the hotel.

By car:

The hotel is 44.7km from the airport by car via A3.

From Station Neumarkt

On foot:

The hotel is just a 1.4-kilometer walk from Neumarkt's main train station.

By bus:

Take bus 561 or 562 to Neumarkt Landratsamt, which drops you right in front of the hotel. You can instead take bus 563 to Neumarkt Neuer Markt, just 160m from the hotel.
